

NESRT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this annual monetary award is to promote the advancement of the radiation therapy profession by encouraging educational achievement in its constituency, both practicing therapists and those learning the profession.

AWARD:

The scholarship prize includes a monetary award, a one-year free membership to the NESRT, and free registration to the annual Spring Conference at which the scholarship is awarded. The monetary amount of the award is to be determined annually by the NESRT Board. This award will not exceed 10% of the treasury.

ELIGIBILITY:

Student:

1. senior student in an accredited radiation therapy program in New England
2. GPA of ≥ 3.0 or its equivalent
3. current member of NESRT
4. two letters of support
5. essay of 500 words or less describing the individual's personal radiation therapy goals and how this award will help in achieving the goals as well as indicating past or current leadership roles in the community or radiation therapy

Therapist:

1. current member of NESRT
2. current ARRT registration
3. enrolled in a program that will advance the profession of RT
4. two letters of support
5. essay of 500 words or less describing the individual's personal radiation therapy goals and how this award will help in achieving the goals as well as indicating past and current involvement in radiation therapy activities and any leadership record

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Student:

The following will be submitted to the Selection Committee by December 31st for award at the following annual meeting:

1. cover letter indicating desire to be considered for the award

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2. verification of enrollment in an accredited New England radiation therapy program (include entrance date and expected completion date)
3. verification of GPA ≥ 3.0 or equivalent
4. documentation of current NESRT membership
5. two letters of support
6. three copies of an essay of 500 words or less describing the individual's personal radiation therapy goals and how this award will help in achieving the goals as well as indicating past or current leadership roles in the community or radiation therapy – no identifying information (i.e. name, hospital name, etc.) should be on the copies

Therapist:

The following will be submitted to the Selection Committee by December 31st for award at the following annual meeting:

1. cover letter indicating desire to be considered for the award,
2. documentation of enrollment in a program that will enhance the profession (include entrance date and expected completion date)
3. documentation of NESRT membership
4. documentation of ARRT registration
5. two letters of support
6. three copies of an essay of 500 words or less describing the individual's personal radiation therapy goals and how this award will help in achieving the goals as well as indicating past and current involvement in radiation therapy activities and any leadership record – no identifying information (i.e. name, hospital name, etc.) should be on the copies

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Student:

The award will be given at the NESRT Annual Spring Meeting.

Therapist:

The selection among submissions will be determined by and announced at the NESRT Annual Spring Meeting with award given after submission to the Chair of satisfactory (≥ 3.0) completion of at least one course in the enrolled program.
